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Ruffled

I love the idea of having a soft cozy neck piece. Sometimes I find the long scarves a bit cumbersome, and sometimes I find the skinny scarves impractical.

The solution: A ruffled scarf that has the ability to cover up all of my neck yet short enough to not weigh me down or get in the way.

Size: 6 ½" x 33"

Materials

- 2 100G skeins of Malabrigo Chunky or 3 skeins Debbie Bliss Cashmerino SuperChunky
- size 11 knitting needles
- 2 buttons (optional)

Gauge

3 sts= 1" in garter stitch

Directions

CO 22 sts. Knit one row.

Knit 4, turn, K4. K6, turn, K6. K8, turn, K8. Knit across all 22 sts.

Repeat from * to * until you have 3 yards of yarn left. Bind off.

If desired, wrapping the last stitch before each turn will eliminate a whole from occurring.

If you want the scarf to fit snugle around your neck, I suggest adding a button or two to the scarf. No need to add a buttonhole, since the knit is loose enough to fit most any button.



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
